



Emergency Procedures Policy

At **Asbestos KCB Ltd**, safety is our highest priority. This Emergency Procedures Policy outlines the steps we take in the event of an asbestos-related incident to protect our team, clients, and the public.

1. Purpose

This policy ensures that all asbestos-related emergencies are handled quickly, safely, and in full compliance with UK health and safety regulations.

2. What Is an Emergency?

An asbestos emergency may include:

- Accidental disturbance of asbestos-containing materials
- Unexpected release of asbestos fibres
- Damage to sealed asbestos waste
- Exposure of workers or members of the public to suspected asbestos

3. Immediate Actions

In the event of an emergency, the following steps will be taken:

- **Stop work immediately**
- **Evacuate the area** and restrict access
- **Isolate the affected area** where possible
- **Avoid further disturbance** of materials
- **Notify a supervisor or responsible person immediately**

4. Site Control Measures

Our trained team will:

- Establish a controlled exclusion zone
- Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Prevent unauthorised access to the area
- Clearly mark and secure the affected location

5. Decontamination Procedures

Where required:

- Personnel will follow strict decontamination procedures
- Contaminated clothing and equipment will be safely contained
- Waste will be double-bagged and clearly labelled

6. Reporting & Investigation

All incidents will be:

- Recorded in an incident log

- Investigated to determine the cause
 - Reported in line with legal requirements where necessary (including RIDDOR if applicable)

7. Professional Response

We will ensure that:

- Only trained and competent personnel handle the situation
 - Licensed contractors are engaged if required
 - All clean-up and disposal is carried out safely and legally

8. Communication

We will:

- Inform affected clients promptly
 - Provide clear guidance on safety measures
 - Cooperate with relevant authorities where required

9. Prevention & Training

To reduce risk, we:

- Provide ongoing staff training
 - Follow strict asbestos handling procedures
 - Carry out risk assessments before all work
 - Use approved equipment and materials
